GROWTH SPARKS FIRE ALARM UPGRADE

EXPANSION BRINGS UPGRADE

Added growth in our enrollment for next year creates a two-fold response by LCA admin. First: for classroom needs, LCA is hiring additional teachers, opening two more classrooms, which are two grade classrooms rather than three grade classrooms. This addresses the classroom needs; however, our total building usage will require additional compliance with regulations on educational facilities having more than 50 persons present each day. To comply, LCA is planning our second response to enrollment growth through upgrades in our current fire alarm system.

Fire Alarm System regulations for Group E (Educational) occupancy are required now that our numbers have crossed this enrollment threshold. This is a two-contractor process requiring an electrical contractor to hard-wire the units together, and a fire alarm contractor to install the components with necessary state and local permits/approvals.



Much prayer and research has poured into this project. "This project has been a journey that has brought us down many paths only to find out we didn't need one thing, or that a specific solution wouldn't work, then going down another path to another end." says Mrs. McKamey. "It's been a journey of prayer and waiting that has finally yielded miraculous provision. From our original quotes to costing 50K to 80k we are now pursuing a solution that is estimated between 10 and 12k." Work during the months of June, July and August to install the equipment, will enable us to commence the school year August 22nd, 2022.

As we gear up to begin this project, we are praying for partnership through donations with churches and friends of LCA who are interested ensuring the growth of our school.
