PARTNERSHIP WITH PARENTS

What is partnership? As a Classical Christian academy, we endeavor to partner with parents. What does that mean and how do we do it well? According to Mandi Moore, in "10 Predictors of Success at School," if parents can understand and commit to 10 things, from three primary categories, they can ensure they get the most value they can out of their Classical Christian school.

PARENTS ARE PRIMARY

The first and foremost thing to remember is that parents are the primary educators. They are the first and most influential teacher in their child's life.

That means you, Mom and Dad, are your child's most important teacher.

This is why LCA so values communication FROM parents. If we don't hear from you, we can't know how to support what you are teaching at home. Do you communicate often with your teacher or LCA administrator? Why or why not?

PARENTS ARE THE PROTECTORS

The school can't be. The parents actually have to be that frontline of defense to keep their kids from being malformed by the culture around them.

ACE SCHOLARSHIP-- DEADLINE TO APPLY -- APR 15 ALL FAMILIES HOPING TO TAKE ADVANTAGE MUST APPLY

Both new and returning families hoping to receive an ACE scholarship for the 2024-2025 school year must have their completed application turned in before April 15th.

What we learned last year:
This scholarship is a great opportunity for LCA families. Most families qualify, and the application requirements are fairly easy compared to other scholarships.
Scholarship eligibility is based on income from

 Scholarship eligibility is based on income from 2023 taxes which must be filed prior to applying for ACE. This means you may need to do your taxes early if you are hoping to be considered.

 ACE does not grant extensions for their scholarship deadline, even if you have an IRS extension for your taxes.

 Be sure your application is complete and you have submitted any requested forms prior to April 15. Ask the LCA office for help if needed.
