We are excited that we are again participating as a school in a very unique & special fundraiser called *Feed the Need*. This is a service-based fundraiser where, instead of selling candy bars or cookies, we will gather our students together on March 8th to pack 10,000 meals which will then be shipped to Bangladesh to orphanages & schools. Last year we were blown away by the impact of this fundraiser and cannot wait to see what the Lord will do this time.

These meals serve both a physical & spiritual need for those who receive them. Of course, humans need nourishment for their immediate survival, but they also need spiritual nourishment from a Savior that can sustain them for eternity. As missionary activities are restricted in Bangladesh, these



meals become a tangible expression of God's love to needy and displaced people group. Please be praying over all of those involved in this ministry. There is a great need for hope in these villages, and it is only Jesus that can supply that everlasting hope.

We kicked off our event on January 29th and will be raising funds until the packing party on March 8! Kick-off night was a great success as we fellowshipped together over a meal & had over 29 families register for Feed the Need.

Over these remaining weeks, our students and families will be raising funds towards our overall goal of \$35,000. We are currently four weeks into our six-week long fundraising drive and can report that we have raised \$14,531 which is 42% of our goal!

Our overall fundraising goal at the beginning of 2023-2024 academic year was \$167,000 dollars. As we approach the middle of the year, we are happy to report that our overall need has decreased to \$125,000 though cost saving efforts, donated supplies, and reduced staffing required for classes.
